CASW ELECTION PRIORITIES

A BOLD and JUST FUTURE



CASW is seeking commitments from all federal parties to Reconciliation following the lead of Indigenous People, Communities, and Organizations with concrete commitments to actualizing the TRC Calls to Action and the MMIWG Calls for Justice, and fully realizing the articles of the United Nations Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples (UNDRIP).

CASW also seeks commitments to **concrete anti-racism plans** and echoes the calls of Parliamentary Black Caucus that federal government must immediately lead in the **collection** and stewardship of disaggregated race-based data.



The Conservative Party of Canada (CPC) has committed to:

<u>fund an investigation</u> into graves at all residential schools

to develop a detailed and thorough set of resources to educate Canadians on history of residential schools in Canada.

to build a national monument in Ottawa that honours residential school survivors

There are no mentions of Black Canadians, racism, or antisemitism in the official platform



The Liberal Party of Canada's (LPC) has committed to:

spend \$321 million on a range of initiatives related to searches of residential school to support Indigenous communities conducting searches, and name an interlocutor to suggest new legal measures

fully implement the Act respecting First Nations, Inuit, and Métis Children, Youth and Families with long-term, predictable, and sufficient funding to support the full implementation of the Act

Accelerate the implementation of the Federal Pathway to Address Missing and Murdered Indigenous Women, Girls and 2SLGBTQQIA+

strengthen the Anti-Racism Strategy by doubling funding and improve the quality and amount of data collection Statistics Canada does regarding hate crimes

Present a National Action Plan on Combating Hate by 2022 as part of a renewed Anti-Racism Strategy

Develop a Black Canadians Justice Strategy to address anti-black racism and discrimination in the criminal justice system



The New Democratic Party of Canada's (NDP) has committed to:

call for a special prosecutor to investigate crimes committed within the residential school system

establish through legislation a National Council for Reconciliation to provide oversight and accountability in the effort to fully implement all 94 TRC Calls to Action

create a national action plan to dismantle far-right extremist organizations, including those that promote white supremacy and establish national standards for identifying and recording hate crimes

work with the provinces to improve race-based data collection



The Green Party of Canada's (GPC) has committed to:

ensure non-status First Nations' children living off reserve have access to Jordan's Principle

Create a mandatory national database on the collection of police use of force data, disaggregated by race, ethnic background, national origin, age, and other identities to track victims of incidents of use-offorce by police and better understand the extent of systemic racism in Canadian policing
