## **CFS Child & Family Therapist Employment Opportunity**

The MLTC Child & Family Services Department is seeking a compassionate, dynamic, highly motivated individual to fill the position of Child & Family Therapist. Under the direction of the CFS Senior Director, the Child & Family Therapist is responsible for the assessment and treatment needs of children and youth suffering from mental health diagnosis and various other complex needs. Services will include intake, assessment, diagnosis, treatment and crisis intervention.

This role involves working with a comprehensive team and requires maintaining effective working relationships with children and families, schools, hospitals, physicians, psychiatrists, behavioral interventionists and consultants to coordinate services, cooperation, resolve conflicts, influence outcomes, provide community consultation and training on emotional and behavioral disturbances.

### **Qualifications:**

- Preferred: Master's Degree in Psychology, Social Work, or Counselling
- Secondary: Bachelor's Degree in Social Work with five (5) plus years' experience in counselling may be considered
- Registration with the appropriate, applicable professional designation will be required.
- Able to write comprehensive assessments and maintain appropriate clinical/client/administrative records are required.
- Sound knowledge on counselling practices; able to maintain strict confidentiality; and able to demonstrate strong ethical judgements.
- Excellent communication skills (verbal/written), assessment skills, interpersonal skills, time-management skills, and organizational skills.
- Required to work flexible hours, which will often include evening and occasional weekend work including supporting the 24 hour on call process.
