The ideal candidate is a skilled influencer and a proactive problem-solver who has demonstrated integrity and authenticity. The ideal candidate can negotiate and resolve conflict, looks at innovative means to accomplish goals and has strong decision-making abilities. This individual is a role model with the ability to motivate, mentor and coach a high-functioning, diverse team.

The Manager, Family Services is responsible for ensuring the effective delivery of services to children, youth and families, by planning, managing and controlling the development, implementation, delivery, coordination, and evaluation of services, programs, and policies in the areas of child protection, children in care, family services, and extended family care in Whitehorse and the Region. The effective delivery of 24-hour child protection programs and services is also ensured by providing professional and developmental leadership to unit supervisors, and by managing the unit's financial, personnel and administrative functions. The incumbent also provides consultant services to the Branch and/or Department corporate functions (policy, finance, IT and human resources) to ensure the development of new or revised programs and functions to meet the needs of children and families.
