The Territorial Executive Director, Child and Family Services (CFS) is located in Yellowknife and provides leadership and strategic direction to the entire CFS system in the Northwest Territories; which includes the Department of Health and Social Services and three Health and Social Services Authorities.

The incumbent is responsible for planning and directing the development and implementation of CFS strategic initiatives, system planning, and quality improvement planning, including compliance monitoring, performance of practice audits and evaluation of program outcomes and effectiveness. The incumbent directs projects and research on best practices to achieve system improvement/reform and provides ultimate direction to all CFS staff and programs delivered by and for the CFS system.

Salaries start at \$133,692 - \$190,983 per year, plus a Northern Living Allowance (\$3,700 for Yellowknife), health and dental, a generous pension plan, outstanding leave benefits, relocation assistance, and professional development opportunities and education support.
