



HOW TO: Logging in to the CASW website

1. Navigating to a page for members only will show the following page:

(To prompt a log in page, navigate to www.casw-acts.ca/en/user)

2a. If you already have an account, you may log in using your email and password. The 'Request new password function' will send a link to the email address used while creating your account, logging you in and allowing you to change your password and account details. Please note this link expires after time or after being used once.



2b. If you do not have an account, first click on the 'I want to create an account' button, then fill out the short form and click 'Create new account'.
